

I HA Preps for 2006 Show

Indiana Heritage Arts will be mailing the “Call for Entries” for our 2006 annual exhibition and show to be held at the Brown County Art Gallery in Nashville. Last year over 160 artists entered nearly 500 paintings and the show committee is hoping for more this year. Indiana Heritage Arts gave nearly \$80,000 in prize money and purchase awards at last year’s exhibit which was narrowed to 130 paintings by the judge who then went on to pick the prize-winners. Artist members will be getting their entry forms in the mail however any eligible artist can call IHA at 812-988-0099, write to IHA at PO Box 509, Nashville, In 47448 or download a form from this website.

All artists with an Indiana connection are invited to enter the annual exhibit and sale. Over 18,000 in prize money will be awarded. Eligible work must have been completed within the past two years and not exhibited in any previous IHA exhibition. No photography or computer art will be accepted. All entries must be properly framed and ready to hang. All works must be offered for sale.

Paintings may be in oil, acrylics, alkyd, casein, and egg tempura. Watercolors include all water media and must be under glass or plexi. Pastels, drawings, printmaking, and mixed media are also eligible.
