Exhibition Calendar

- May 8 Entry cards and entry fee due
- June 1 Delivery of entries 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM
- June 2 Jury notification cards mailed
- June 6 Patrons and Artists Reception at 6:00 PM
Awards Ceremony at 7:30 PM
- June 7 Exhibition opens to the public
- June 21 Last day of exhibition
- June 22 Artist pick-up day, 10:00 AM to 3:00 PM.

June 23 – July 31 Award winning artists will be invited to hang work in the IHA Gallery through July. Other work may be included at the discretion of the Show Committee.

Artists wishing to pick up non-selected work during the exhibition June 7 – 21 may call (812) 988-4609 to make an appointment. No walk-ins. A donation of \$5 per day will be assessed artists whose works are not picked up on or before June 25.

Eligibility

Any artist 18 years or older and who is a present or former resident of Indiana. IHA board members are eligible to exhibit; however, they may not compete for awards.

Eligible Work

- Painting: Oils, acrylics, alkyd, casein and egg tempera
- Watercolor: All water media under glass or plexi
- Pastels, drawing, printmaking and mixed media

Works must have been completed in the last two years and not exhibited in any previous juried show. No photography or computer art. Work completed under the supervision of an instructor, copies of other artists' works or published photographs are prohibited.

Exhibition Awards

Approximately **\$20,000** in awards will be presented by our judge where excellence is determined. They are...

IHA Gold	\$5,000
IHA Silver	\$3,000
IHA Bronze	\$2,000

4 – \$1000 Awards of Excellence

10 – \$250 Awards of Merit

A **\$500** IHA Directors' Award, **\$500** People's Choice Award and several unspecified awards will also be presented.

Rules (read carefully)

- All submitted works must be for sale.
- No entry may exceed 52 inches in any direction, **including frame**. Strictly enforced, no exceptions.
- All entries must be properly **framed** and ready to hang. This includes frames in good repair, clean mats, clean glass or plexi, STRAP HANGERS ONLY with proper strength picture wire. **NO EXCEPTIONS**.
- No wet paintings will be accepted.

Failure to meet these requirements will result in rejection of work from our show. The Hanging Committee will have the final decision.

Entry Instructions

- Entry forms with fee must be postmarked by May 8, 2008.
- Entry forms and fee will not be accepted on delivery day.
- Entry fees (3 works): IHA Members – **\$30**
Non-Members – **\$40**
- **Notice:** To become an active artist member of IHA, submit an additional check for \$35 along with your \$30 entry fee.

Delivery of Work

Securely attach the correctly numbered entry card to the UPPER BACK LEFT CORNER OF EACH WORK.

All work must be hand delivered to the Brown County Art Gallery in Nashville, Indiana, on June 1 between 9:00 AM and 4:00 PM.

Artists are encouraged to include a brief written biography or brochure along with their entry or at time of delivery.

Exhibition Sales

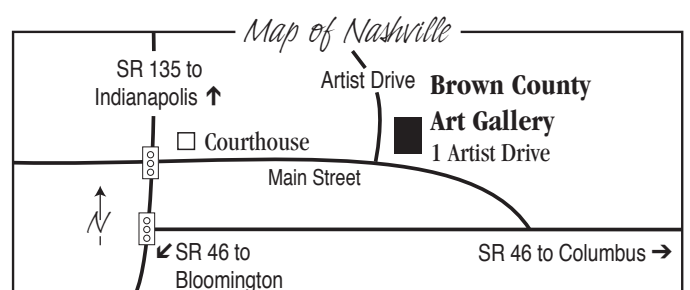
Indiana Heritage Arts, Inc. will retain thirty-three percent on all sales. IHA will collect and remit Indiana sales tax. The shipping of sold work is the responsibility of the artist.

Juror of Selection / Awards

Each year Indiana Heritage Arts searches for a nationally recognized, out of state judge/juror to select approximately 120–30 outstanding works for display in our annual exhibition. This year we are honored to have Curt Hanson as our juror for the 30th Annual IHA Exhibition. Curt studied in the atelier of R. H. Ives Gammell, the Boston School painter who had trained with William McGregor Paxton. Curt lives and works in Cornwall, Connecticut.

Agreement

Indiana Heritage Arts, Inc., Brown County Art Gallery Foundation, Inc., and their agents and representatives will make every effort to protect artist's work, but will not be responsible for loss or damage; artists participating agree to hold them harmless from all such claims and losses. Permission to reproduce works for publicity is considered granted. **Artists must supply their social security number in order to collect prize and purchase awards.** Entry constitutes an agreement with all conditions of this prospectus. Entry rules will be enforced.
